

To quote one of our students, "We are here to play with people, not things". With this in mind, we ask that parents and children consider the following (taken from the Grade 3-4 newsletter to families) when children ask to bring special toys or things to school.

<u>Toys/Special Items:</u> If you choose to bring toys or other special items to school with you, please keep the following in mind:

- Be prepared to share! Others may want to look at/play with your item, or play WITH you while
 you use it. We do NOT exclude people from our games/activities simply because they do not
 have the "correct" item or brand.
- o It may get broken or lost intentionally or otherwise, these things sometimes happen. We will all do our best to be respectful of other people's belongings, but accidents do occur and some things may not be replaceable/fix-able.
- Items are for use during "free-time", NOT during class time!
 Consider the above carefully; if you are not prepared to live with these terms, please do not bring your item(s) to school with you!

Another factor for families to consider is that one of our fitness goals is for children to be actively engaged in play during recess and lunch outdoor time. This is a time for children to be running, climbing, playing skipping or ball, etc.

<u>Toonie Tuesday Pizza</u> Every Tuesday, students can purchase slices of pizza from Dominos for \$2 per slice. Orders are taken first thing in the morning and pizzas are delivered to classrooms by 12:30. Proceeds go towards the Grade 7 year-end trip. Grade 7 thanks you for your support. The first pizza day will be held on Tuesday, October 7th.

School Supplies Reminder: We would appreciate it if the school supply fee of \$10/child (Grades K to 4) and \$15/child (Grades 5 to 7) could be handed into the office or the classroom teacher as soon as possible. Cash or a cheque made out to the school are accepted. Thank you.
