



St. James School is proud to be starting a pen pal program with our friends at Santa Elena Primary School in Belize, Central America. This is an English speaking, Catholic school in a rural community of this small country. The population of the school is over 1000 children. The pen pal program is open to any student from St. James School, but those students in K-2 will need their parents help with the letter. The letter is to be hand written, error free and to include as many interesting facts about yourself and your community as possible. You will NEED to include 1 picture of yourself in your school uniform that has been professionally developed (no home

printer copies please). It will be very exciting for the student in Belize to see a picture of you in your school uniform as they wear uniforms too! All letters are due into Mrs. Inzunza by <u>Friday</u>, <u>November 28</u>, <u>2014 at NOON sharp!</u> Thank you in advance for participating in one part of our global outreach project!

### Easy Ways to Support Our Students

- If you purchase items from Cobbs Bread, let them know that you are supporting St. James School and the school receives a portion of the sales.
- When you take your refundables to the bottle depot, let them know that you want the money credited to the school.



- Label ALL your children's clothing items, including outdoor jackets; that way, we can easily return items to the proper owner (Mabel's Labels are great for this).
- Regularly check our Lost and Found if your child is missing an item of clothing (we often have many unclaimed items - uniform pieces, shoes and runners, jackets, etc. - that end up being donated to the used uniform store or to

charity).

- Check to make sure that your child's uniform pieces are in <u>good condition</u>. If your child has pants with ripped knees, shirts that are stained, sweaters with holes in them, etc. it is time to purchase either new or slightly used pieces from our Uniform Store.
- The next new and used uniform sale will be held on <u>TUESDAY</u>, <u>NOVEMBER 25<sup>TH</sup></u> from 2:30 to 4:30pm and 6:30 to 7:30pm. This service is offered to you by uniform volunteers and we greatly appreciate their work on your behalf.

#### LOST AND FOUND

Each month several items in the Lost and Found are unclaimed. To date, we have donated items to the used uniform sales and to the Salvation Army. Please remind your children to check for their missing items. These are regularly put on display and students are often reminded to check the Lost and Found.
