

#### School Uniform News

For those who wish to sell their items through the school's uniform system, please be aware of the following:

- Only CRESTED items in very good condition will be accepted for sale at the school.
- You must attach a paper to each item with your name, phone number, the date, and the price clearly printed on the paper.
- We accept crested items for sale as a service to families; we do not make any money off these items as we are not a consignment store.
- If, after 3 school months, the item has not sold, we reserve the right to remove the price and to place the unsold item with the donated items. If you wish unsold items back, it is your responsibility to contact the uniform coordinator (not the school secretary) to collect your unsold items.

We will continue to accept non-crested items (pants, skirts, skorts, etc.) but only as donations.
