

From the Principal's Desk

Holy Week and Spring Break!

This year Holy Week falls within the Spring Break. When I first started teaching at St. James School, Spring Break was only a week long and a second holiday was given for Holy Week. The Bishop's intention was that families have the opportunity to



spend what is arguably the most sacred time of our liturgical year together. For many reasons we no longer follow that model, and we as a school relish the opportunity to teach during Holy Week, providing our students opportunities to acknowledge the sacredness of the season. This year, the opportunity is yours. I sincerely hope that you will take time away from the busy-ness of Spring Break to pause with your loved ones and acknowledge the power of this time. Perhaps you may choose to partake in the extended liturgy of the Triduum, an extended celebration that begins Holy Thursday with the washing of feet (by the way, Pope Francis changed the wording of the rules on this to now include women and young people, not just men as it has been until now, and Father Dale will be including women for the first time this coming Thursday!) and then continues on in one unbroken Mass through Good Friday and is concluded at the Easter Vigil Saturday night (which involves the initiation of a good number of new comers to our faith via the RCIA program, all of whom are connected in some way to our school this year! How exciting!). Or perhaps you will find a more individual way to acknowledge the season by taking a meditative walk in the spring sunshine, partaking in a retreat or pausing on the beach of some ocean paradise and praising God for the gift of that moment (you lucky dog you!) However you choose to mark the week, I wish you much love and peace as you do it and I hope you know how truly blessed we are. May God continue to bless each and every one of you, keep you safe and bring you back to us at St. James School on April 5th.

By taking part in the devotion to Our Lord on this Sunday you can gain a Plenary Indulgence under the following conditions, you must be in a state of grace, receive Holy Communion that Sunday and go to Confession either the week before or following Divine Mercy Sunday, or that Sunday. You must also pray for the Pope's intentions, take part in the devotions, and be free from all attachment to sin, even venial sin. Confessions during the week prior to Divine Mercy Sunday will be Monday to Friday 5:00 pm until 6:00 pm. On Divine Mercy Sunday at OLOV, confessions will be heard beginning at 1:00pm until

2:45 pm. Eucharistic Adoration will be occurring at the same time as confessions.

Divine Mercy prayers will begin at 2:45 pm and then Mass will follow at 3:00 pm. You can prepare for this feast by making the Divine Mercy Novena, which starts on Good Friday. Novena prayers are available in the churches. This Mass serves as your Sunday obligation.
