SJS Got Talent 3rd Annual

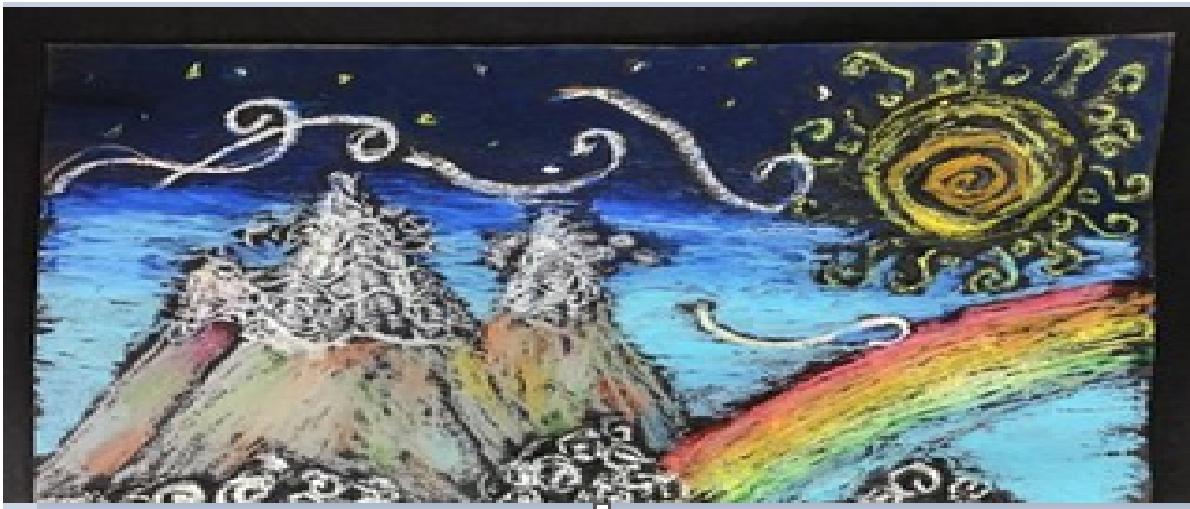
