Updated BCCDC Guidance for What to Do If You've Tested Positive for COVID-19

COVID-19 should stay home until their fever has resolved and they feel well enough to participate in daily activities.

This update is consistent with information that came out last week that there is no longer a requirement to self-isolate upon testing positive for COVID-19.
